INSUF

- Task (irrelevant or write few lines)
- Format (choice and/or using it wrong)
- Register (choice, essentially formal/informal)

▶ 2.1 ORGANIZATION

- **Writing:** Paragraphs + connectors + punctuation
- **Speaking:** Connectors + logical flow + fluent interaction

- ▶ To narrate, describe, illustrate, review, clarify, ask or offer information, opinion, advice...

SUF

- Organization, Functions, Sentence Cohesion are OK.

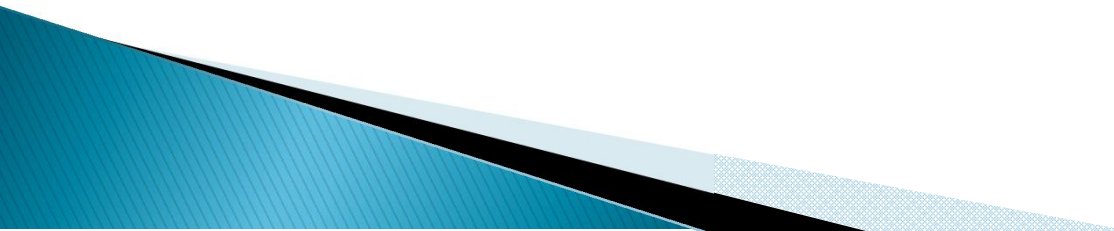
INSUF

- Organization, Functions, Sentence Cohesion are CLEARLY deficient or inadequate.

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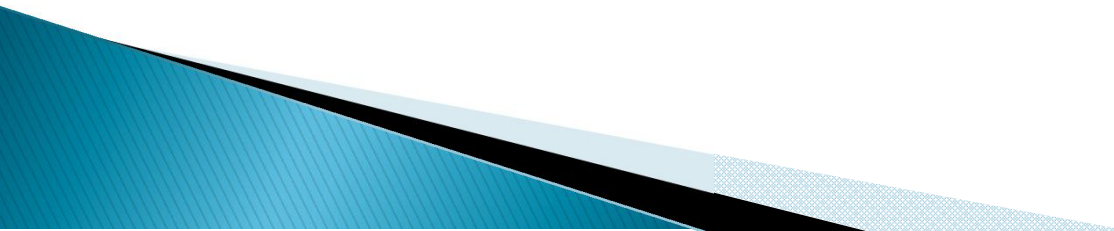

5 Parameters

EXCELLENTE: 5 are excellent

BIEN: 5 are good

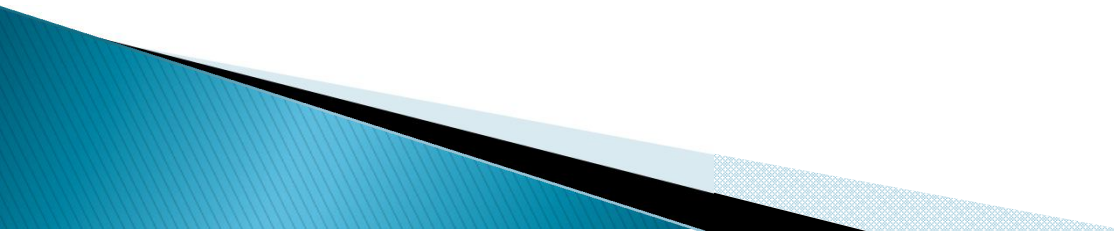
SUFICIENTE: Generally OK some errors
Nothing “insuficiente”

INSUFICIENTE: 1 out of 5 is “insuficiente”
Some serious errors

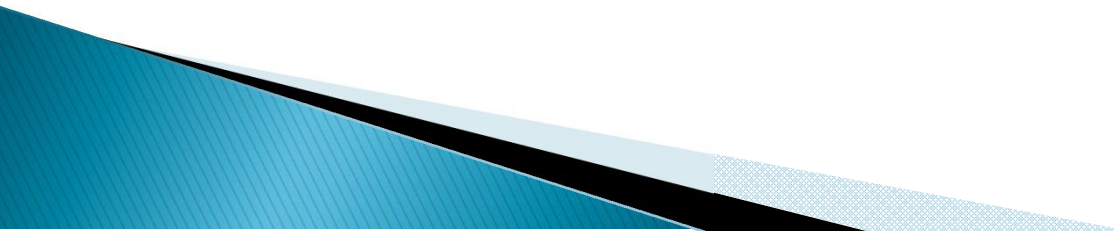
INADECUADO: Clearly deficient/inadequate
2 out of 5 are “insuficientes”

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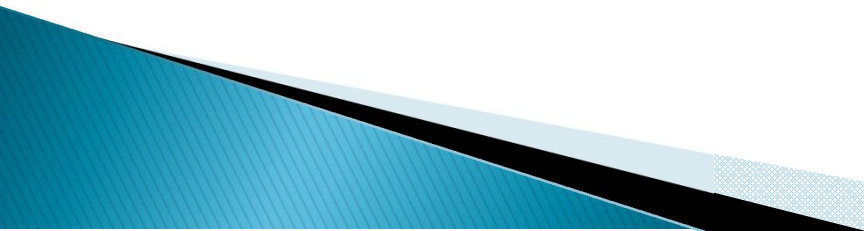
WHAT TO EXPECT

 - ▶ **3- What register should be used here?**
 - ▶ **4- What functions are expected to be used?**
 - ▶ **5- What grammatical and lexical items are expected here?**
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AN EXAMPLE

- ▶ **It is your first time in London. Write an e-mail to your best friend talking about the city.**
 - ▶ **1- Functions:** Describe
 - ▶ **2- Format:** E-mail
 - ▶ **3- Register:** Informal
 - ▶ **4- Grammar:** Simple present, comparatives,...
 - ▶ **5- Vocabulary:** Place, weather, feelings...
