



# NATIONAL AND NATURAL PARKS OF ANDALUSIA

## Environmental Policy

National and Natural Parks are areas whose conservation deserves preferential attention. For this reason, an ideal framework is provided for the integration of environmental protection, prevention and quality actions through an Environmental Management System in accordance with UNE-EN ISO 14001, based on the following principles:

- To apply comprehensive and unified procedures for the management and use of resources aimed at the **conservation of the natural heritage** and the **sustainable development** of the environment through social participation.
- To comply with the applicable legal requirements and others endorsed by the competent environmental ministry in the development of its activities.
- To provide services compatible with conservation, sustainability and **integrated management**, both on behalf of the competent environmental ministry and of third parties.
- To promote the **continuous improvement** of the management of the National and Natural Parks of Andalusia, applying environmental criteria.
- To train and raise awareness among the organisation's staff working at the National and Natural Parks of Andalusia on sustainability, **environmental protection**, public use, ecotourism and environmental services.
- To promote measures aimed at **preventing pollution** in the natural environment, mitigating and adapting to **climate change**, protecting biodiversity and **land and marine ecosystem services**.
- To provide the framework and resources needed to set and review environmental objectives and targets.



## Environmental Management System

Implemented by the competent environmental ministry as a reference framework to improve efficiency in the use of natural resources, management of public use, ecotourism and environmental services at the National and Natural Parks of Andalusia.
