The plants that live in rocky and craggy areas have long flexible stems to avoid being buried and a powerful root system to prevent being dragged. They must also be able to start new shoots when the stems break.

Among the most attractive species that can be observed in the rocky areas are the Linaria and the Sierra Nevada Violet (*Linaria glacialis* and *Viola crassiuscula*).
