The Megaforbias are herbaceous plants of great size.

In terms of physiognomy, these communities are like tall grasslands. Their requirements: permanent humidity during all or most of the year, quality water and deep soil rich in organic matter. Their enclaves are highly ecologically valuable due to their uniqueness and aesthetics, with the abundance and colour of their flowering.

Species characteristic of these communities are: The blue aconite or wolfsbane (*Aconitum burnatii*) and the yellow wolfsbane (*Aconitum vulparia*), the primrose of Sierra Nevada (*Primula elatior* subsp. *lofthousei*), columbine (*Aquilegia nevadensis*), the sparse cineraria (*Senecio elodes*), etc.
