

# Espinar

Forming a border and first stage of replacement for the mountain holm oaks and the oak groves.

Grows in fresh and deep soil. Can appear in abandoned soil from old mountain crops from harvested holm or Kermes oaks.

The hawthorn plants are a vegetal formation with shrubs, usually with thorns and stingers, with sharp ends of their branches.

The species that characterize the “espinar” are: the hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*), blackthorn of the sierra (*Prunus ramburii*), barberry (*Berberis hispanica*) and wild rose hips or rosebushes.
