The *Quercus pyrenaica* oak groves are conserved in the Aljíbico sector in the south of Europe, on the cusps of the mountain ranges. In most cases, they do not reach tree size, forming a dense scrub of deciduous leaves. Currently, it suffers from regeneration problems.

Its whitish appearance is due to the abundance of hairs on its strongly lobed leaves.

Its superficial roots help stabilize the soil and prevent erosion where it lives.
